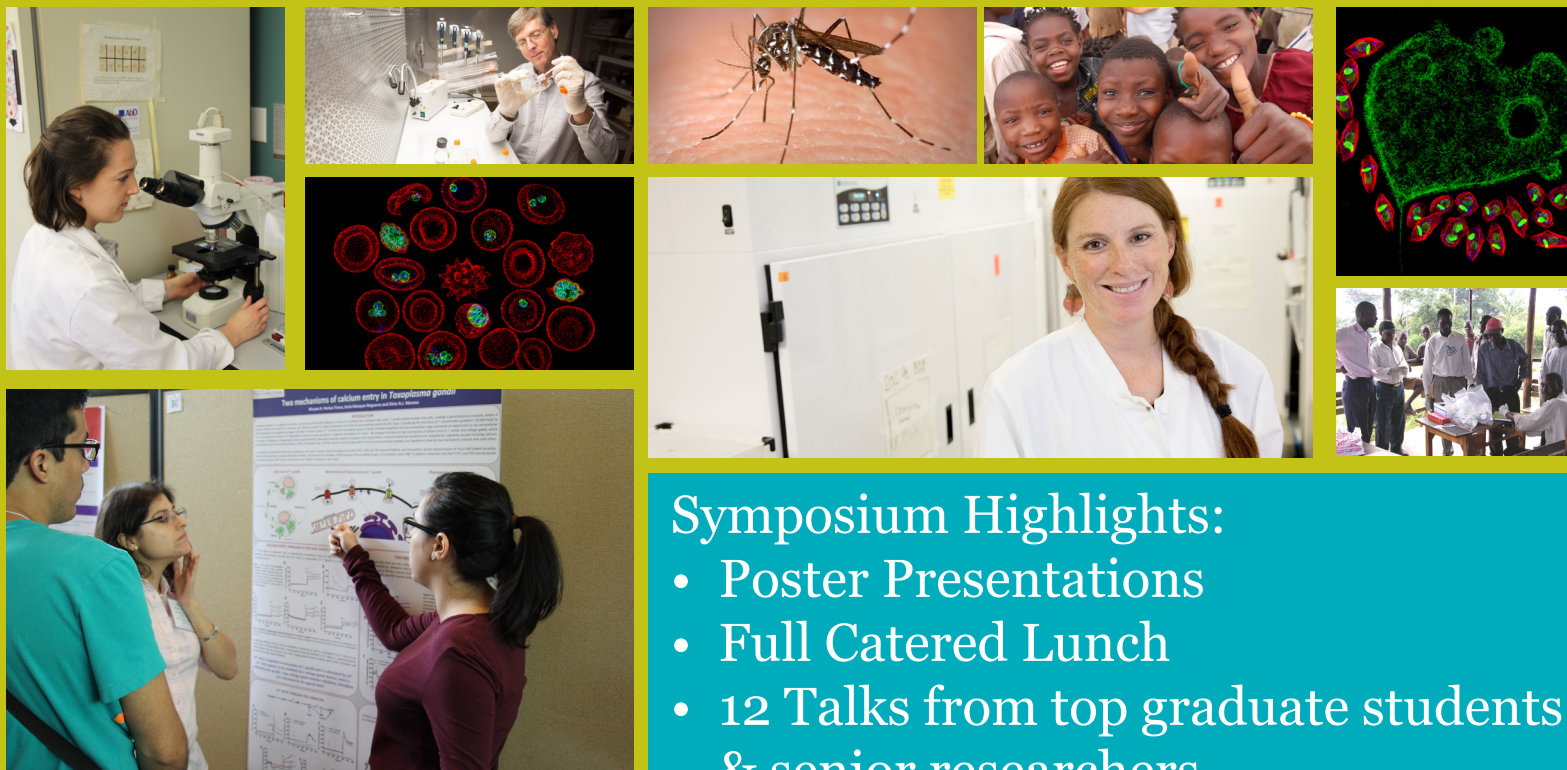


28th Annual Molecular Parasitology & Vector Biology Symposium
