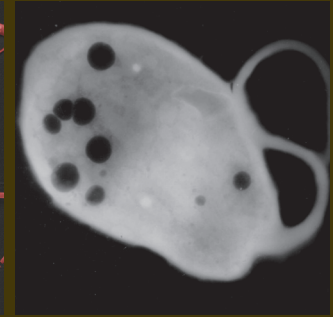
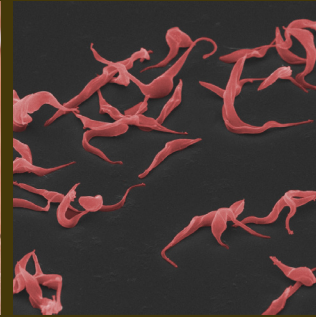
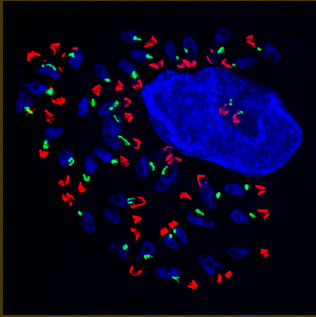


# 30<sup>th</sup> Annual Molecular Parasitology & Vector Biology Symposium
